


How to Uninstall Adobe Reader and Install a Previous Version

Uninstall Adobe Reader

Open your “Applications” Folder and drag any Adobe Reader icons and/or folders to the “Trash” icon on your desktop.




Download Adobe Reader

Download the Adobe Reader version you would like to install. Below is a table of Adobe Reader options for different system configurations:


Processor	MAC OS Version	Compatible Adobe Reader Version(s)
Intel	10.4.11 – 10.5.5	X, 9.4, or 8.2
	10.5.6 – 10.6.4	X or 9.4
Power PC	10.4.11 – 10.5.5	9.4 or 8.2
	10.5.6 – 10.5.8	9.4

Go to <http://get.adobe.com/reader/otherversions/> and select your operating system (specific to Intel and PowerPC Macs), your language preference, and the version you would like to install. Click on the “Download now” button.




Install Adobe Reader

After downloading the installation file, go to your “Downloads” folder and double-click on the downloaded installation file to install Adobe Reader (the filename may differ from what is pictured below, depending on which Adobe Reader version you downloaded in Step 2 above).



If you see a warning like the one below, click on the “Continue” button



Click on the “Continue” button in the Adobe Reader installer.



Select the location you would like to install to and click on the “Continue” button.



Click on the “Install” button



After the installation is complete, click on the “Close” button



Adobe Reader is now installed and can be accessed from your “Applications” folder.
